Details of organisations being supported

Overseas

- South American Missionary Society – we support the work of Alejandro and Doris Mesco in Peru. Alejandro visited CPC during September. An extra payment towards the cost of the visit was requested by SAMS.
- Church Mission Society – we support the work of Andy and Suzie Hart in Tanzania.
Andy is a vet and Suzie runs a craft workshop for those with disabilities. Andy and Suzie visited CPC with a group of dancers from Tanzania during September.
- Christian Aid and Tear Fund are large international Christian relief funds which we have supported for many years.
- Brian Anderson is working in Hungary and spoke at CPC in January. We hope to send a team there in summer 2009. He is Simon Jones' father-in-law.

The African Support fund covers our various links with churches in Africa, which included

- Charles Semwaga – evangelist for the Diocese of Cyangugu in Rwanda, which a team led by Howard Dawson visited in October
- Juliet Semwaga – Charles' wife, who is training to be a teacher
- Tubakunde – a project to run an orphanage, led by Pam Hajnasrollah – and where Tracy Bowen spent six months during 2007.
- Francis Kiiza works at the school next to Tubakunde, and needs an eye operation, which we agreed to support at the November PCC.

Home mission

- Youth With A Mission works with young people in York
- YoYo provides Christian workers for schools in York, and also run children's and youth events and training events for children and youth workers in the city.
- One Voice York is the grouping of evangelical Churches, running various events across York. David Casswell is co-chairman of this organisation.
- Church Pastoral Aid Society provide help for many parishes across Britain. They are also patron of CPC.
- York Besom provide practical support to people in York, matching offers of goods and services with required help. Some of our young people painted a house through York Besom this summer
- Carecent – provide support to homeless people in York. At present they do not need financial support, but we do give our harvest gifts to them.
- Family Matters York run courses in parenting across York, including two recent courses at St. Mark's
