I'm very sorry to be so slow in communicating, but communication is difficult where we are working.

We continue with the work of establishing the mission in Cabanaconde and our visits to the villages. In the month of May we had the festivities of the cross, which are located in the highest mountains and the community invited us to celebrate the Holy Communion. It was wonderful, because it is an opportunity to share the word of God, with all those present.

The tradition is to put the cross down, adorn it with flowers, raise it again and celebrate the Holy Communion



In our visits to the villages, we found people who are homeless, neglected, some gave their lives to Christ, such as Fernando, a man without hope, living among the mountains, caught in the vice of alcohol, but on the day we met on the road, he took a decision to receive Jesus Christ in his heart.
