Letitia our curate writes:

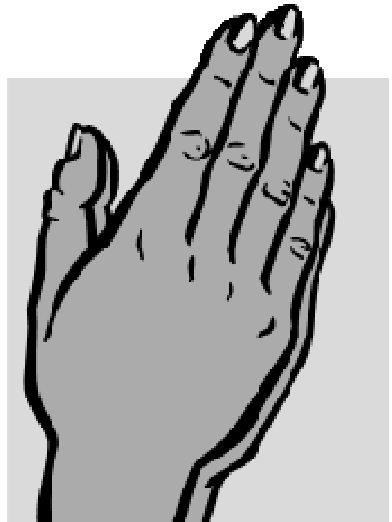
This week I have heard the words 'let's pray' on more than one occasion.

New office opening times From Monday 6th Sep the office will be open 9.30am to 11.30am, Monday to Friday.

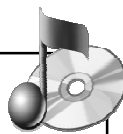
