The last chapter in the last book in the Bible. Genesis starts in a garden, revelation finishes in a garden of paradise – and the way in is through another – the garden of Gethsemane.

But because we have the Bible we can have a look and see how things are going to end...

They will see his face, and his name will be on their foreheads.

Questions:

What is your general view of the book of Revelation?

What strikes you about the physical description of this heavenly City?

What other attributes of heaven do you particularly value?

Think about the symbolism and significance of the tree that crops 12 times a year, and it's leaves...

The harvest of souls is a joyful and serious subject. How do you relate to the urgency in verse 7?
